ceedings of several irregular and clandestine bodies of Masons, styled lodges, within this District.

It is to be hoped that the G. A. O. T. U. will ere long so change the hearts of our erring and misdirected Brethren, as to induce them to cease from such violation of well established principles of exclusive Masonic Sovereignty.

All of which is nevertheless respectfully submitted.
