

the end of bowsprit or spinnaker boom (whichever be the greater) to the foremast, and a perpendicular by measuring from the deck to the highest block used for setting the spinnaker, and dividing the multiple of these measurements by two.

Private distinguishing signals must be carried in all races, as provided for in Rule VIII.

The Committee deem it desirable to encourage a junior and non-resident membership, and have provided that:—

Youths of 18 and under may become members of the Club and enjoy all its privileges excepting the right to take part in elections, by paying an entrance fee of three dollars and an annual subscription of two dollars.

Gentlemen residing not less than twenty miles from the Club's House may become members of the Club, enjoying all its privileges, by paying an annual subscription of two dollars, without entrance fee.
