An Act to amend the Act respecting Seizures and Sales by authority of Justice, chapter 85 of the Consolidated Statutes for Lower Canada.

HER Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Preamble. Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows :----

 The first and second sub-sections of section 4 of chapter 85 of the Sub-sections Consolidated Statutes for Lower Canada, intituled: "An Act respect-1 & 2 of sec. 5 ing Seizures and Sales by authority of Justice," are hereby repealed, Stat I. C. repealed.

4. When lands and tenements are seized by the Sheriff under a writ Formalities to of execution, he shall advertise three several times in the Canada Gazette be observed and in the newspaper, if published, in the district in or nearest to the ^{by} Sheriff.

10 Parish or Township in which the land is situated,—that the sale thereof will take place on some certain day after the expiration of four months from the date of the first advertisement.

2. If the seizure be made in a parish the Sheriff shall proclaim the Iflands seized said sale at the church door of the parish in which the premises are are situated

15 situated, immediately after Divine service on the three Sundays next ^{in a parish}. preceding the sale, and shall cause a copy of the said advertisement to be fixed on the door of the parish church.

Lands *en roture* shall be sold at the door of the church of the where lands parish where seized, and lands and tenements held in free and com- to be sold. mon soccage or otherwise than *en roture* shall be sold at the town hall or other public place where the meetings of the Municipal Council are held, in the township or parish where the lands so seized are situated.

20 4. But lands or tenements in any city, town or *chef-lieu*, where the Lands in city, Sheriff's office is kept, or in the Banlieu (if any) of such place, may sold as they have heretofore lawfully been at the Sheriff's office.
