

QUEBEC.

The Lieutenant Governor—The Honorable RENE EDOUARD CARON, LL.D., Q.C. S. of the late M. Augustin Caron, of St. Anne in the seigniory of Beaupré, County of Montmorenci, who twice represented the County of Northumberland in the old L.C. Assembly. B. at St. Anne, 1800. Ed. at the Quebec Seminary and at the College of St. Pierre. M. the dau. of the late Germain De Blois, Esq., of Quebec. Called to the Bar, L.C., 7 Jan., 1826. Created a Q.C., 1848. Has been Presdt. of the General Council of the Bar of Quebec; of the *Institut Canadien*; of the Literary and Historical Society, and of the *Société de St. Jean Baptiste*, all of Quebec. Received the degree of LL.D. from Laval University, 1865; created a Commander of the Order of Saint Gregory the Great, 1873. Entered the City Council of Quebec, 1832, and in following year was elected Mayor of the City, a position he continued to fill until 1837, and again, subsequently, by appointment of the Crown, for several years.
