

BILL.

An Act to amend the Act of 10 and 11 Vic. cap. 23, relative to Masters and Servants, and to extend the provisions thereof to Mechanics and others.

**W**HEREAS it is expedient to extend the provisions of the Preamble.  
Act passed in the Session held in the tenth and eleventh year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, "*An Act to regulate the duties between Master and Servant and for other purposes therein mentioned,*" 10 and 11 Vic., c. 23. to Mechanics, Artificers and other persons employed in any trade, manufacture or occupation in Upper Canada, so that they shall have the same remedies thereunder as are thereby provided for servants and laborers; Be it therefore enacted, &c.,

That from and after the passing of this Act, the word "Masters" in The said Act to extend to journeymen and their employers in Upper Canada.  
10 the said Act named shall mean, include, embrace and comprehend employers of all journeymen, mechanics, artizans and others employed in any trade, manufacture or other employment in the Upper Canada, and the word "Servants" or "Laborers" in the  
15 said Act named shall mean, include, embrace and comprehend all journeymen, mechanics, artificers or others employed in any trade, manufacture or employment within Upper Canada; and all and every the remedies therein provided shall be extended and be  
20 construed to extend to all employers and employed in Upper Canada, as fully and effectually as in the said Act is provided for and between masters and servants or laborers.
