Governor to apportion such increase. which such increase of salary shall be assigned to such office; and if the said amount be not sufficient to cover the increase of salary so 2 assigned to such office, then such increase of salary shall not for that year exceed such amount; and provided also, that it shall be lawful 4 for the Governor to apportion such increase of Salary among the persons conjointly holding and filling such office, in suchmanner as 6 he shall deem expedient, having a due regard to the length of service of each of the persons in the performance of the duties of such 8 office, or of a similar office in any other Court or any other District.

Accounts to be sworn to. XIX. And be it enacted, that the accounts which shall be rendered 10 to the Inspector General under this Act by each of the above mentioned Public Officers, shall be by such Officer sworn to as true and 12 faithful, on oath to be taken before one of the Judges of any of the Courts aforesaid.

Lower Cana- XX. And be it enacted, that this Act shall apply to Lower Canada da. only. 16
