An Act to amend chapter fifty-four of the Consolidated Statutes for Upper Canada, intituled "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada."

HER Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Preamble: Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:—

- 1. The two first lines of section three hundred and thirty, chapter Sec. 330 cap. fifty-four of the Consolidated Statutes for Upper Canada, being an Act 54 Con. Stat. initialed "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper U.C., amended Canada," are repealed.
- 2. The following words shall be substituted for the repealed portion of the said three hundred and thirtieth section of the said chapter fiftyfour, and shall, in lieu thereof, be read as a portion of said three hundred and thirtieth section,—
  - "The Council of every Township, County, Town, and incorporated Village, may also pass By-laws."
  - 3. The following words shall constitute an additional Sub-section, New Sub-secand shall be read as a portion of said three hundred and thirtieth Section, tion.
- "County Municipalities by their Councils shall control the Statute Control of Labour for one and a-half mile, on each side of a County Road, where rested in such County Road has been gravelled or macadamized; but no such control shall be exercised by such County Municipalities until a By-Law cils in certain has been passed and published, setting forth their intention to control cases.

  The said Statute Labour, or so much thereof as the Municipality of the

County may require, the residue, if any, to be and remain at the disposal of the respective inferior Municipalities.
