

An Act to amend chapter fifty-four of the Consolidated Statutes for Upper Canada, intituled "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada."

HER Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:—

1. The two first lines of section three hundred and thirty, chapter fifty-four of the Consolidated Statutes for Upper Canada, being an Act intituled "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada," are repealed. Sec. 330 cap. 54 Con. Stat. U.C., amended

2. The following words shall be substituted for the repealed portion of the said three hundred and thirtieth section of the said chapter fifty-four, and shall, in lieu thereof, be read as a portion of said three hundred and thirtieth section,—

"The Council of every Township, County, Town, and incorporated Village, may also pass By-laws."

3. The following words shall constitute an additional Sub-section, and shall be read as a portion of said three hundred and thirtieth Section, New Sub-section.

4. "County Municipalities by their Councils shall control the Statute Labour for one and a-half mile, on each side of a County Road, where such County Road has been gravelled or macadamized; but no such control shall be exercised by such County Municipalities until a By-Law has been passed and published, setting forth their intention to control the said Statute Labour, or so much thereof as the Municipality of the County may require, the residue, if any, to be and remain at the disposal of the respective inferior Municipalities. Control of Statute Labor vested in County Councils in certain cases.
