

and place for such Leases by Auction, shall previously be given, at least twice in the Montreal News-Papers.

XXII. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the Trustees, at their first meeting, may fix upon a day and place for meetings to be thereafter periodically held, and meetings for the purposes of this Act, may at any time, when necessary, be called by any two of the Justices, who, in writing, shall direct the Treasurer and Clerk to give written notice of the time and place for such meeting, by leaving such written notice three days, at least, previous thereto, at the Domicile or usual place of residence of the said Trustees respectively; and the said Treasurer and Clerk, when so required in writing, shall give such notice accordingly; and every meeting may adjourn to any other day which shall be designated in their resolution of adjournment.

XXIII. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that if at any time before the expiration of this Act, the said Road shall be in such repair, and the Funds applicable thereto be in such productive state, as to admit of the Tolls and Rates hereby granted, being diminished, and yet sufficient remain for fulfilling the purposes of this Act, then a diminution thereof shall be made in such proportions as the said Trustees, or any three or more of them, at a meeting assembled for that purpose, shall determine: and afterwards, if need be, the Tolls and Rates may be augmented, but not so as to exceed the Rates herein-before authorized to be taken.

XXIV. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that this Act shall not extend nor be construed to extend, to oblige the said Trustees, or to render them liable to make or keep in repair the said Road, from and after the days of _____ until the day of _____ in each and every year, nor to authorize them to demand or receive any Toll or Rate, for a Cariole, Train or other winter Carriage or conveyance during the period aforesaid, nor to exempt any person liable by Law to the making and keeping in repair, the said Road for the above-mentioned period from any labour for that purpose.

XXV. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that if it should happen that the improvement and repair of the said Road, at any other time than in winter should be neglected, it shall be lawful for any person or persons having paid Toll thereon and finding security to pay
