IV. Provided also, That no Person or Persons Quakers to affirm 17. 17000000 uses, and they have been so whatever shall be deemed or construed to be Quakers, within the true Intent and Meaning of this Act, except such as shall affirm, in the Form before directed, that he, she, or they is or are of the said Profession of People called Quakers, and have been so for one Year next before such Affirmation made.

V. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall To be deemed a be deemed to be a public Act, and be judicially public Act. taken notice of as such.
