I have the honore to send you herewith a letter from the chief Metalic asking permission to cut lumber on their land.

As I told you before, I think it is necessary to give them permit, because there is a certain number of them that are not able to go and hire out, and they must earn their living some way. They have now a chance to sell 5 or 600 pieces of boom lumber at a good price from the Chelms by Mills, from which company there is never any trouble to collect the dues.
