Sir,

Referring to your application of the 20th ultimo to acquire a road across Seabird Island from Lot 66, Group 1, to Nahleach Siding, British Columbia, I beg to say the method of procedure should be as follows: the Municipality should first pass a by-law authorising them to acquire the necessary land for the purposes of said highway. The road should be surveyed and the question of remuneration to the Indians considered. It is also necessary to have the consent of His Royal Highness in Council before work of construction should be commenced.
