Tou should assist only those who are unable to earn a livelihood or have no relatives or friends to help them. Se good enough to seport how many are being regularly rationed. The purchases made appear to be greater than what should be necessary for the six Indians reported by you in July last as being destitute and for whom the Department authorized the issue of rations.
