In further reference to your letter of the 29th Mar stating that Mr. Superintendent Rogers had been instructed to hold an investigation under oath regarding the complaint against Police Magistrate O'Connor and Constable Edwards. I beg to suggest that Mr. Indian Agent Brown of Port Arthur be given ample notice of the date and place of the investigation so that he may be able to produce whatever evidence he may have in support of these charges. The witnesses and their witnesses are Indians who may be absent from the reserve and sufficient notice should be given to secure their attendance.
