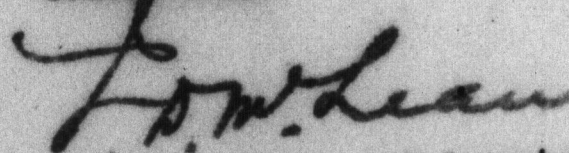
Dear Sir,-
