


In reply to your request for information regarding the
 conditions for payment of a pension or gratuity to a person
 in the employ of this Department, it appears that you are under a misapprehension
 of the said request. All persons who have been employed by this
 Department are not entitled to receive pensions. The
 Service Act provides for payment of superannuation under certain
 conditions, but such conditions are not applicable to you. Only
 those persons who contributed regularly to the Superannuation
 Fund are entitled to participate in payment of superannuation
 money.
