person arrived at Rupert I interviewed the said
Persons, and gave him questions to find out
whether they came out of the Dominion or Provincial
government to take up our land matters, Mr
Kelly replied and said I guess they all sent us,
so I find that their action is not quite true,
Notwithstanding my best, read the copy of said 27th
and the 14th Dec, at the end of reading Mr Kelly
conferred to agitate the said 27th March - 14th Dec
