

Shrunken clover seeds, ribgrass, and the smaller weed seeds pass through the oblong openings while the plump seed remains above.



**Fig. II.**—One-fifteenth-inch perforated zinc sieve—perforations  $\frac{1}{16}$ -inch in diameter, used as a riddle or upper sieve for cleaning red clover.
