SEINES - See NETS.

SETTLERS — Game laws do not apply to, in unorganized townships, or territory not divided into townships, if game killed for food, and not to sell. (G.P.A, s. 27; 57 Vict. c. 57, s. 6, O.)

May use night lines and set lines in certain cases (55 Vict. c. 10, s. 14, O.)

SHAD—Spears, grapnel hooks, negog and nichagans prohibited. (R.S.C. c. 95, s. 14, s-s. 8.)

SHERIFF - See DEPUTY WARDENS.

SNARES - See NETS - TRAPS.

SNIPE-Close season between Dec. 15th and Sept. 15th. (G.P.A., s. 3, s-s.I. (a.))

May not be sold till Sept. 15th, 1897, no matter where killed or procured. (57 Vict. c. 57, s. 1, O.) See EXPORTATION.

SPAWNING—Catching fish during spawning time, or disturbing spawning beds prohibited. (0.0.C.)

SPEARING — Salmon, trout, lunge, maskinonge, winaniche, bass, barfish, pickerel, whitefish, herring or shad, may not be taken by means of spears. grapnel hooks, negog or nishagans. (R.S.C. c. 95, s 14, s-s. 8.)
