

**May not be taken by nets, etc.,** without a license.  
(55 Vict. c. 10, s. 10, O.)

**SAWDUST** — *See* **POISON — POLLUTION OF FISHING GROUNDS.**

**SEINES** — *See* **NETS.**

**SETTLERS** — **Game laws do not apply to,** in unorganized townships, or territory not divided into townships, if **game killed for food,** and not to sell. (G.P.A., s. 27; 57 Vict. c. 57, s. 6, O.)

**May use night lines and set lines** in certain cases  
(55 Vict. c. 10, s. 14, O.)

**SHAD** — **Spears, grapnel hooks, negog and nishagans prohibited.** (R.S.C. c. 95, s. 14, s-s. 8.)

**SHERIFF** — *See* **DEPUTY WARDENS.**

**SNARES** — *See* **NETS — TRAPS.**

**SNIFE** — **Close season between Dec. 15th and Sept. 15th.** (G.P.A., s. 3, s-s. 1. (a.) )

**May not be sold till Sept. 15th, 1897,** no matter where killed or procured. (57 Vict. c. 57, s. 1, O.)

*See* **EXPORTATION.**

**SPAWNING** — **Catching fish during spawning time, or disturbing spawning beds prohibited.** (O.O.C.)

**SPEARING** — **Salmon, trout, lunge, maskinonge, winaniche, bass, barfish, pickerel, whitefish, herring or shad,** may not be taken by means of spears, grapnel hooks, negog or nishagans. (R.S.C. c. 95, s. 14, s-s. 8.)
