them at any time; and such traps, nets, snares, gins, baited lines and contrivances, may be destroyed by any person without such person thereby incurring any liability therefor.

None of the contrivances for taking or killing the wild fowl known as Swans, Geese or Ducks, which are described as batteries, sunken punts or night lights, shall be used at any time.

And whereas fur-bearing animals should be protected during the seasons when their skins are of little value, be it enacted that no Beaver, Muskrat, Mink Martin, Racoon, Otter or Fisher shall be hunted, taken, killed or had in the possession of any person between the first day of May and the first day of November; nor shall any traps, snares, gins, or other contrivance, be set for them during such period; nor shall any Muskrat-house be destroyed at any time; and any such traps, snares, gins or other contrivances so set, may be destroyed by any person without such person thereby incurring any liability therefor.
