such special meeting no business other than that so stated shall be taken up.

13. The Committee shall appoint an Examining Board who shall examine all candidates for membership, and who shall also act as a Musical Advisory Board, with whom the Musical Director may consult.

AUDITORS.

14. Two Auditors'shall be elected at the annual business meeting of the Society, to examine the current year's accounts, and to report thereon at the next annual business meeting.

ADMISSION.

15. Membership in the Society shall be open to amateurs and to such professionals as are willing to assist the orchestra gratuitously.

16. Applications for membership shall be in writing, addressed to the Secretary, and shall be by him submitted to the Committee.

17. If the Committee approve of an application the candidate shall submit to examination by the Examining Board as to his or her executive ability.

18. Before examination by the Board the candidate may be invited by the Committee to attend one or more practices of the Orchestra. ing be oth
