feel and lament this prevailing finfulness ; and deputly implore the affiftance of thy grace to reftore us to a dutiful fense of Thee and of ourfelves; befeeching Thee to cleanfe and fanctify our fouls by the influences of thy Holy Spirit; and in the multitude of thy mercies, to do away our offences, and to remember our iniquities no more. O let the light of thy countenance thine upon us this day ! Warm and invigorate our drowfy wills and affections; confirm and ftrengthen our refolutions of amendment ; that we may put away all ungodline's and finful lufts, and earneftly follow after the peace, which they have who love thy law : That fo holding fast the profession of our faith in purity of heart and mind, we may finally become acceptable in thy fight, through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

After the Prayer in the end of the Litany (We humbly befeech Thee, &cc.) the following shall be added.

O LORD, most good and powerful, we thy finful people, here affembled before Thee, do acknowledge it thine unspeakable mercy, that for our manifold and heinous provocations we are not utterly confumed, and given over a prey to our enemies. We confels with forrow and confusion our long unfruitfulnels under the means of grace, and light of thy Gofpel, and the many wonderful deliverances of our Church and Civil Constitution, which thou in thy great goodness hast vouchlafed unto us. Shouldest thou, O Lord, enter into judgment with us for the crying fins that abound among us, our profaneness and infidelity, our herefies and schifms, our gross impurities, our lukewarmness in thy cause and neglect of thy ordinances, and other manifold offences, thou mighteft juftly inflict upon us the feverity of thy wrath, and deliver us up to the infults of our cruel enemies : But there is mercy with Thee, therefore shalt thou be feared. Thou art the Lord God, tender and full of compatiion; not willing that any thould perifh, but that all should repent and be faved. Look down therefore, we befeech Thee, with an eye of pity and loving kindnefs on thy fervants, who with broken and contrite hearts do here bewail our tranfgreffions and wretchednefs. Let our land, in this time of trouble, still enjoy the light of thy countenance, and the blessings of thy bountiful hand; and fo work upon our hearts and minds by the influences of thy Holy Spirit, that being turned from the error of our ways, and created to newnefs of life, we may walk before Thee in all holinefs and righteoufnefs in this world, and inherit thine everlafting kingdom: in that which is to come, through the merits of Jesus Christ, our only Mediator and Advocate. Amen.
