Synopsis of Canadian North-West.

HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS

A NY even-numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manitoba, Saskatchewan, and Alberta, ez-cepting 8 and 23, not reserved, may be homesisaded by any per-son who is the sois head of a family, or any male over 13 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section of 169 acres, more or less.

Application for entry must be made in person by the applicant at a Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the district in which the land is situate. Entry by proxy, may, however, be made at any Agency on certain condi-tions by the father, mother, son, daughter brother, or sister of an intending homesteader.

DUTIES. - (1) At least six months' residence upon and cul-tivation of the land in each year for three years.

(2) A homesteader may, if he so desires, perform the required residence duties by living on farming land owned solely by him, not less than eighty (80) acres in extent, in the vicinity of his homestead. He may also do so by living with father or mother, on certain conditions. Joint owner-shir in land will not meet this re-quirement.

(3) A homesteader intending to perform his residence duties in accordance with the slove while living with jarents or on farms ing land owned by himself must notify the sagent for the district of such intention.
