sin, that you might wear a crown of glory—fruit of grace divine. His side was pierced with a soldier's spear, that you might find a resting place in His heart for ever. He bore the judgment of God against sin, that you might enjoy an eternal weight of glory. Oh! then, be careless no longer—slight the Saviour of sinners no longer. Believe in Him, according to the word of God. But, oh! see that you believe now. Can you lie down to sleep another night, with all your sins upon your soul? Surely not. Look to Jesus, and your eyes shall be enlightened, your burden removed. "To him give all the prophets witness that through I is name whosoever believeth in Him shall receive remission of sins." Acts. x. 43.

## THE BLOOD.

Without shedding of blood is no remission. (Heb. ix, 22).

When I see the blood I will pass over you. (Ex. xii, 13).

He hath made peace through the blood of His cross. (Col. i, 20.)

The blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanseth us from all sin. (I Jno. i, 7).

Redeemed with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot. (I Pet. i, 19).
