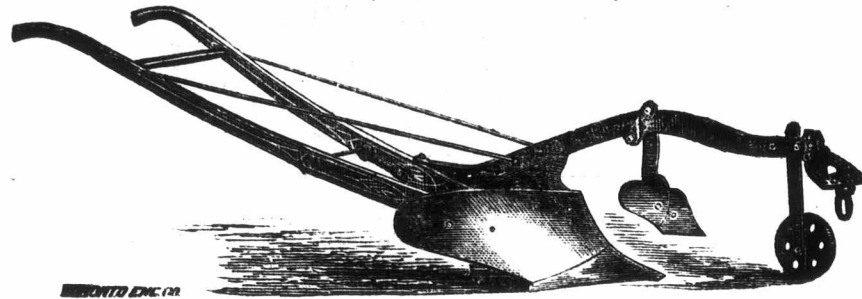

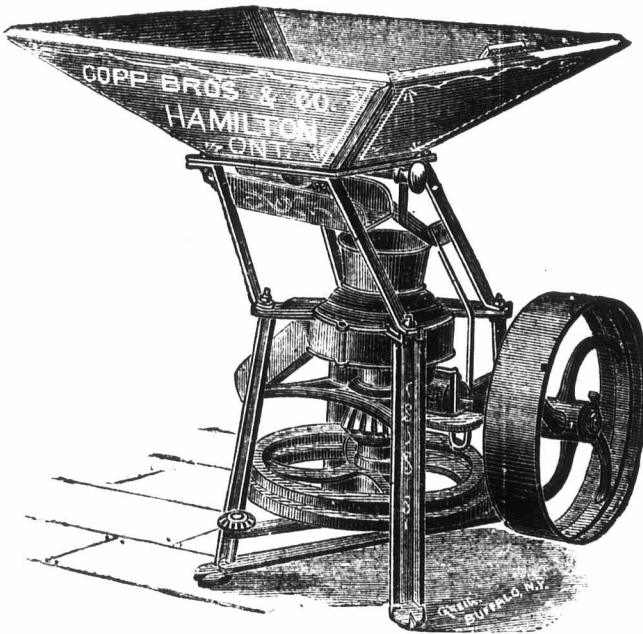

**GRAIN CRUSHER.**

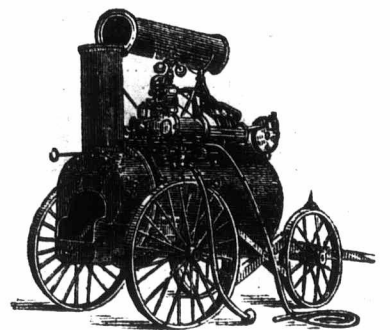
