six shillings to Thomas Brimar, being the balances due to them for labour performed in the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty-four, on the Nerepis Road, the said sums to be paid out of the monies granted for the Great Road between Fredericton and Saint John.

Sunday Schools.

To His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, a sum not exceeding filty pounds, to be applied and expended by him for the encouragement and promotion of Sunday Schools in this Province.

For clearing obstructions in Harit's Mill stream.

To such Commissioners as His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor may be pleased to appoint, should he think it expedient, to lay out the sum of one hundred pounds, in clearing obstructions in the stream leading from Harit's Mill to the Great Lake on the Oromocto.

Courier between Bathurst and Riyer Restryouthe.

To Commissioners to be appointed by His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, the sum of forty pounds, in aid of individual subscription to defray the expence of a Courier to be employed between the Town of Bathurst and the River Restigouche.

Madras School. School for Childeen of colour in St. John. and Facdericton. To the Governor and Trustees of the Madras School in New-Brunswick, the sum of seven hundred pounds towards the support of that Institution throughout the Province, such part of the said sum as may be necessary for that purpose, to be appropriated to the support of a school for Children of Colour, in the City of Saint John: And a sum not exceeding one hundred pounds part of the said sum to be appropriated for a similar School in Fredericton.
