
HOUSE OF ASSEMBLY, *LOWER - CANADA.*

Quebec, Wednesday the 5th March, 1800.

THE House being met,
A Message by Mr. *William Boutillier*, Gentleman Usher of the
Black Rod.

Mr. Speaker,

It is His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor's pleasure, that this
Honourable House do immediately attend him in the Upper House of
Legislature.

The House went up accordingly; and being returned—

Upon motion of Mr. *Berthelot*, seconded by Mr. *Dumas*,

ORDERED, that Mr. *Berthelot* have leave to bring in a Bill further to
continue for a limited time, an Act passed in the 36th year of
His Majesty's reign, intituled, " An Act for making a tem-
porary provision for the regulation of Trade between this
Province and the United States of *America*, by Land, or
Inland Navigation."

He accordingly presented the said Bill to the House, and the same
was received and read for the first time.

Mr. Speaker reported, that the House had attended His Excellency
the Lieutenant Governor in the Legislative Council Chamber, where
His
