



PROCLAMATION.

BY HIS EXCELLENCY LIEUTENANT-GENERAL

Sir JOHN COAPE SHERBROOKE,

Knight of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Lieutenant-Governor and Commander

in Chief, in and over His Majesty's Province of Nova-Scotia, and its Dependencies,

Vice-Admiral of the same,

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of this Province stands prorogued to Thursday the 7th instant :

I have therefore thought fit further to prorogue the said General Assembly, to Thursday the tenth day of February, 1814, *then to meet for the Dispatch of Business* ; of which all persons concerned are hereby required to take notice, and govern themselves accordingly.

GIVEN under my Hand and Seal at Arms, at Halifax, this 4th day of October, 1813, in the 53d year of His Majesty's Reign.
