training of persons to the use of arms, and to practise Military evolutions or exercises; and to authorize Justices of the Peace to seize and detain arms collected, or kept for purposes dangerous to the Public Peace, being read;

The Bill was accordingly read a second time, and committed to a Committee of the whole House.

*Resolved*, That this House will immediately resolve itself into the said Committee.

The House accordingly resolved itself into the said Committee; and after some time spent therein, Mr. Speaker resumed the Chair; and the Honorable Mr. *Cameron (Peel)* reported, That the Committee had gone through the Bill, and made amendments thereunto.

Ordered, That the report be now received.

The Honorable Mr. Cameron (Peel) reported the Bill accordingly, and the amendments were read and agreed to.

Ordered, That the Bill be now read the third time.

The Bill was accordingly read the third time.

Resolved, That the Bill do pass, and the title be, "An Act to prevent the unlawful "training persons to the use of Arms, and to practice Military evolutions or exercises, and "to authorize Justices of the Peace to seize and detain Arms collected or kept for pur-"poses dangerous to the public peace."

Ordered, That the Clerk do carry the Bill to the Legislative Council, and desire their concurrence.

The Order of the Day for the second reading of the Bill to amend cap. 32 of the Consolidated Statutes of *Canada*, relating to Agriculture, being read;

And the Question being put, that the Bill be now read a second time; the House divided :--And it was resolved in the Affirmative.

The Bill was accordingly read a second time; and committed to a Committee of the whole House for the next sitting this day.

The Order of the Day for the second reading of the Bill to amend the Act respecting the Election of Members of the Legislature, being read;

The Bill was accordingly read a second time; and committed to a Committee of the whole House for this day.

The Order of the Day for the second reading of the amendments made by the Legislative Council to the Bill, intituled, "An Act to make further provisions in relation to the "Temporalities of the United Church of *England* and *Ireland* in this Province," being read;

The said amendments were accordingly read a second time, and agreed to.

Ordered, That the Clerk do carry back the Bill to the Legislative Council, and acquaint their Honors that this House hath agreed to their amendments.

The Order of the Day for the second reading of the amendments made by the Legistive Council to the Bill, intituled, "An Act to confirm certain By-laws of the Municipal "Council of the Corporation of the County of *Oxford*, and to confirm sales of land for " taxes imposed under and by virtue of the said By-laws, being read;

Ordered, That the said Order be discharged.

Then, on motion of the Honorable Mr. Attorney General Macdonald, seconded by the Honorable Mr. Attorney General Cartier,

The House adjourned.
