## Local Market.

London, Thursday, Nov. 9.  
Everything combined to make this morning's market a good one. The clear, keen weather, the good condition of the roads, and the fact that previous markets have been small, all contributed to make better one of the largest and most satisfactory Thursday markets that have been held for some time past. Apparently there was not an over-supply in any line, and as one exchange from supplier to supplied followed steadily after another, the effect was seen on the cheery faces of the customers, and by the serene look of content that overspread the features of the farmer. As a general rule the prices of previous markets prevailed today, and seemingly they were satisfactory on both sides. Country was supplied in large quantities. So, also, were eggs, but a larger amount of butter could have been handled with ease, while other commodities were supplied in amounts adequate to the needs.
