Fruit Trees and Vines in Summer and Fall. The way to secure a large crop of fruit next year is to get the trees and vines into condition this fall.

It requires a large amount of water to dissolve some fertilizers, especially phosphate in the form of both acid and Carolina rock.

Large crop takes from the soil nearly all the elements of growth. As stated, all applications of phosphate will be of advantage in the summer, but a little later there should be given a slight dressing of potash.
