**Stock Notes.**

The well known firm of H. Cargill & Son, Cargill, Ont., breeders of pure-bred Shorthorns, have recently made some noted purchases of Shorthorns in Scotland. Mr. W. D. Cargill has been visiting a number of the cattle shows in England and Scotland and has been successful in securing among others the following animals which will be important additions to this well-known herd: the two year-old Shorthorn bull, Orange Duke, from Mr. Adams, of Raade. This animal was first in his class at the Baughorv Show, Aberdeenshire, and was selected by Mr. Cargill as the best animal in the herd. He also bought from Mr. Adams the yearling heifer Duddy, which was also first in her class and adjudged the champion Shorthorn of the above show. Mr. Cargill also bought from Mr. A. Still Nether Augustus, a young cow; Princess Thule II., and her heifer calf, the former being by the bull Denmark, which was champion at Baughorv and Inverarie, and the latter by Maximus. He also took from the same herd two very handsome two-year-old heifers. Mr. Cargill purchased from Mr. Longmore, Rittie, the three-year-old prize cow Crandola and her calf, which has been twice in the prize list at Aberdeen, and also a two-year-old heifer from the Manganese family. Besides these he bought of Mr. Longmore the first prize and champion Aberdeen heifer Costilla. These importations will make the Cargill herd one of the best in the province, and will add very much to the value of Canadian stock-breeding interests. There cannot be too many importations of this kind made during the next few years.

**Brampton Jersey Herd.**

This large herd of Jerseys is fast coming to the front as a winner of prizes. Last year the owners, H. H. Bull & Son, of Brampton, carried off 86 prizes. In this herd, which consists of some fifty animals, are to be found to-day such cattle as Princess Minette, with a record of 18 lbs. 6½ oz. She is a granddaughter of Stoke Pogis 3rd, and is dam of the great Adelaide of St. Lambert, who has just given 200½ lbs. of milk in one month. Corinne, a granddaughter of Kitty of St. Lambert, and sired by Briars Rogers, was winner of second place at the Provincial Fat Stock and Dairy Show 1896. This cow is the dam of Sunbeam of Brampton, a cow of wide reputation and a good worker as well as a show animal. She won six red tickers in 1896, being first everywhere shown, and in 1897 won the sweepstakes as best female, any age, at Montreal, and the milk test open to all ages and breeds at Brantford. Rhoda of Don is also a granddaughter of Kitty of St. Lambert and is sired by Stoke Pogis of Don. She gave with her second calf 47 lbs. of milk per day, which according to the Babcock test made 19 lbs. of butter per week, and has also been very successful in the show ring. Coloma, by Kitty of Stoke Pogis, has a record of 17½ lbs. of butter per week. Jetam's Molina, a worthy daughter of the imp. Jetsam, Minette of Brampton, out of Princess Minette, and sired by Aylesbury, whose sire was Briars Pogis, dam Satin Bird. Minette is but two years old and due to calve in a few weeks, and according to appearance may some day rival her sister, Adelaide of St. Lambert. Princess of Brampton, out of a full sister of Minette of Brampton is a superior heifer and is making an excellent showing. Bettina of Brampton, though only twenty-two months old, is giving over 30 lbs. of milk per day and increasing. She will likely be heard from before the season's fair is over.

At the head of this herd is the imported bull, Brampton's Monarch, Imp. He is admitted by all who have seen him to be an animal of very rare merit, and the firm are now taking orders for his stock, which will be much sought after in the near future. His dam, Manor Lass 2nd, now owned by E. N. Fleming, Toronto, took first everywhere shown on the Island before being imported, and last year, though six months in milk, took first prize and sweepstakes at the Toronto Industrial.

R. H. Bull & Son will make a large exhibit at the Industrial this year, and visitors to the show are invited to inspect their show stock, among which will be all the animals mentioned above.

Mr. JOHN H. DOUGLAS, Warkworth, Ont., reports a very strong demand for Ayrshires this season. The demand has been especially brisk for both heifers and bulls. All his stock are doing well.
