Editor "Bookseller and Stationer".—Your reference to the net price basis on which many books are being sold in the States to-day is timely. I am finding it hard to compete with city stores which cut the prices of new fiction, and do not see why if a remedy can be applied in the States to a similar condition, one should not apply here.

A number of the new novels by popular authors are coming out now in Canadian editions, and we are prevented from selling other editions. Yet, if we do handle Canadians, we find the profit in them is taken away by the department stores cutting the prices away down.

Now it strikes me it is about time to put a stop to this, and I want to know why the chief booksellers do not lay their heads together and see what could be done. Can the publishers of Canadian editions not agree to stop selling to stores that cut on new books?
