A TERRIBLE CONFESSION. GREENSBORO, Tenn., Oct. 30.—Intense excitement exists here over the arrest of one Taylor for poisoning John Swain, a prominent citizen. It appears that he poisoned not only Swain, but men named Jones and Grooms and a fourth man. The poison used was cantharides. He attempted to poison the guard on his way to jail. It is thought he will certainly be lynched to-night.
