The constant increase in the number of patients (6,542 in the past three years) has justified this society in purchasing a suitable building for hospital use in addition to the station at 314 Broome Street. The Hospital, situated at Second Avenue and Seventeenth Street, is now fully equipped, having accommodation for thirty patients. The out-door service is continued as formerly, and additional instruction is now practicable in the various obstetrical operations. The regular course of instruction of two weeks is given during the entire year, and is open to graduates and students of medicine who have completed one course of lectures. Students are admitted in the order in which their applications are received, or assigned special dates when practicable. All deliveries are strictly antiseptic, and in the out-door service cases are attended as in private practice. Lodgings, instruments, and medicines are furnished by the hospital during the two weeks' service, and certificates are issued to those who have performed the service satisfactorily. (Separate apartment for graduates.)
