QUESTION:

Would it be possible at any point for a united Germany within MATO to have any kind of Soviet or Garmany Troaty troops in the Eastern portion?

FOREIGE SECRETARY:

You do have at the moment a large number of Soviet troops in the GDR and clearly one of the questions to be addressed, one of the questions in which the Soviet Union has a clear interest, is what the future arrangements for those should be.

QUESTION (Olivia Vard, Toronto Star):

To follow up on that question, how would the future of a HATO whited Germany affect current megotiations on troop withdrawals and troop strength in Surope?

FOREIGE SECRETARY:

i do not think they would. 'I mentioned manpower, we have now CPE discussions covering manpower levels. We believe that the relatively new American proposals are a correct Western move, as it ware, in those negotiations and I do not think there is an intimate connection between that and the German question we are now considering.
