His Excellency Max de la Fuente today presented his Letter of Credence as Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Peru to Canada.

The ceremony took place at the Supreme Court at 11 a.m. The Chief of Protocol, Mr. Henry F. Davis, presented the Ambassador to the Deputy Governor-General, the Honourable Patrick Kerwin, P.C., Chief Justice of Canada. Mr. Marcel Cadieux, Deputy Under-Secretary of State for External Affairs, and Colonel A. G. Cherrier, Assistant Secretary to the Governor-General, were in attendance on the Deputy Governor-General on this occasion.

The Ambassador was accompanied by *Esteban* *Mesada*, Second Secretary.

Mr. de la Fuente has had a long and varied consular and diplomatic career. For the last four years, he has been Ambassador and Permanent Representative to the United Nations in Geneva.
