PRAYERS

Mr. Leblanc (Laurier), from the Standing Committee on Miscellaneous Estimates, presented the Fifth Report of the Committee, which is as follows:

Pursuant to its Order of Reference of Wednesday, April 9, 1975, your Committee has considered Bill C-44, An Act to amend the Senate and House of Commons Act, the Salaries Act and the Parliamentary Secretaries Act and has agreed to report it with the following amendments:

Clause 1

Strike out lines 10 to 19, on page 1, and substitute the following therefor:

“sum of twelve thousand dollars per annum;

(b) to the Speaker of the House of Commons, the sum of sixteen thousand dollars per annum; and

(c) to the Deputy Speaker of the House of Commons, the sum of eight thousand”

Strike out line 25, on page 1, and substitute the following therefor:

“sum of five thousand three hundred dollars per annum;”

Strike out line 29, on page 1, and substitute the following therefor:

“mons, the sum of five thousand three hundred dollars”

Clause 2

Strike out lines 4 to 9, on page 2, and substitute the following therefor:

“34. (1) For the sessions of Parliament in the period commencing July 8, 1974 and ending December 31, 1975, there shall be paid to every member of the Senate and House of Commons a sessional allowance at the rate of twenty-four thousand dollars per annum.”

Strike out lines 13 to 51, on page 2, and substitute the following therefor:

“(3) For the twelve month period commencing January 1, 1976 and for each twelve month period thereafter, there shall be paid to every member of the Senate and House of Commons, for the sessions of Parliament in each such period, a sessional allowance at the rate per annum that is obtained by multiplying the sessional allowance payable to each such member for the twelve month period immediately
