3. For what member or members does each of the above stenographers daily work?

4. How many bilingual stenographers are on the Members' Stenographers Staff?

2. How many stenographers are on the Members' Stenographers Staff this session?

*Mr. Pouliot*—On Monday next—INQUIRY OF MINISTRY—1. In each department and in the Members' Stenographers rooms or anywhere in the House of Commons, were there any typewriters in good order which were not used on February 4, 1932?

2. If so, how many in each department in the Members' Stenographers rooms or anywhere in the House of Commons?

*Mr. Pouliot*—On Monday next—INQUIRY OF MINISTRY—1. During the last sessions, were the stencils drafted by Members of Parliament submitted to any censorship before being printed?

2. If so, who was the censor, when was he appointed and what was his salary?
