

I think that it would be quite possible for an R.M.C. graduate to commence the Oxford work in Physics, and Dr. King, our Macdonald Professor of Physics, agrees with this. Here the situation is different and there is no reason whatever why a candidate should not be encouraged.

I do not feel competent to make any further statements, even concerning natural science, without considerable inquiry.

I am sure that in special cases candidates from the R.M.C. could be accepted by Oxford, and I would recommend the Trust to make a special study of the matter.
