## HOMER MACK HANGS UP NEW RECORD FOR RACING ON THE ICE

Paces Three Fastest Heats at Hillcrest Park—Big Crowd Enjoys Sensational Racing—The Results.

The many thousand harness racing enthusiasts who attended the trotting and pacing races yesterday afternoon at Hillcrest Park witnessed three of the best races seen at a half-mile track in many moons. Not only were the races well filled, but they were intensely contested. In some of the heats it was impossible to name the winners until almost from the judge's stand. Jack McLean of Calgary cut loose a good thing in the third race, the free-for-all, when Homer Mack 3 to 1 choice in the betting, well played by the "wise set," came home in front in the first three heats. Homer Mack ran the first two heats in 2:14, and the last in 2:14. The time of the world's record of 2:13, made by Gratian Royal at Dufferin Park a few days ago.

It is quite evident that he could have equaled Gratian Royal's record had Dufferin let him go in the last heat, as the big brown son of Bettelwee dashed into the lead on the first turn, and was pulled by the judge's stand under a pull by five fangs. The time of 2:14 does not only make a new record for the track, but sets up a world's record for the three fastest heats ever run at any half-mile track in many moons.

There was lots of excitement in the 2:30 pace, Brown Hat and Maggie C. both having two winning heats to their credit, and it was not until the fifth heat was run off that the winner was decided.
