This list must be filled up and placed on the top of the trunk when the boy comes to school; ic will be returned in a like manner when he goes home for the holidays.

Application for admission to the School must be accompanied by a statement from the parent or guardian, detailing what sickness the applicant has had; if his general health is good, and if he has any constitutional weakness.

The following letter has been received from the Dominion Health Officer, regarding the healthy situation and sanitary condition of the School.
