



This is a largely magnified Actinomycosis, the so-called star or ray fungus that causes Lump Jaw. The pus from a discharging tumor contains thousands of these germs.



This illustration shows the appearance of the Jaw Bone in an advanced case of Actinomycosis. The bone is entirely honeycombed, and practically destroyed. When the disease has made such ravages as this, the case is of course incurable.
