

DAY IN THE LEGISLATURE
TUBERCULOSIS DEBATE

Dr. Godfrey Commences Discussion
Which Will Be Resumed
on Friday.

Premier Whitney stated in the legislature yesterday afternoon that it seemed desirable to take up the motion of the member for West York (Dr. Godfrey) and that along with it would be considered the bill introduced by Mr. Downey respecting county boards of health and to prevent the spread of pulmonary tuberculosis. The debate would be adjourned till Friday and he hoped that members interested would be present at it.

Dr. Godfrey began by stating that about 3000 deaths a year occurred in Ontario from consumption, or 30,000 in the last ten years. Comparing the financial statistics of the state of Wisconsin, whose population was similar to that of Ontario, he argued that Ontario should make similar efforts to stay the plague. Other states had done much more than Ontario, and large sums were voted annually as well as in the form of intelligent, well-trained physical culture.

Dr. Godfrey stated that the legislature of Wisconsin had passed an act to amend the Bills of Sale and Chattel Mortgage Act. He also mentioned the Amending Voters' Lists Act, which would amend the Ontario Voters' Lists Act as given a second reading. It enables clerical errors and similar mistakes to be corrected by the judge after the revision of the lists.

Mr. McColin's bill to amend the Municipal Act was referred to the municipal committee and the same date he proposed the bill to amend the same act. Mr. Kohler's bill to amend the act respecting municipal boards of refuge was also referred to this committee.

TORONTO BOILERMAKERS WANT CITY CONTRACT
Say It Isn't Fair to Spend \$30,000 Needlessly on a Glasgow Firm.

A vigorous effort is being made to have the city council reject the city engineer's recommendation that a firm in Scotland be given the contract for supplying boilers in connection with the new 15,000-gallon pumping engines at the main pumping station and the 5,000,000-gallon engine at the high level pumping station.

The John Inglis Co., which successfully tendered, offered to install the engines and Babcock and Wilcox boilers at the main station for \$147,340, or to supply the West End boiler, which is manufactured at the Poison Iron Works, for \$145,630, and at the high level station for \$27,700 and \$25,500, respectively.
