Dear Sir

You say the list of white occupants of Indian lands on the Six Nation Reserve, you sent me on the 24th February last, is not complete. That there seems quite a number of names not on it.

I am directed by the Deputy Superintendent General, to request that you will have the kindness to complete the list at your earliest convenience, and if in doing so you find it necessary to visit any portion of the Reserve, you are authorized to do so, and charge this Department \$1.50 per day for your time in preparing the list, plus your actual expenses. Have the kindness to include in your list, ^{white} occupants of land on the Mississauga portion of the Reserve, as well as those on the portion held by the Six Nations, with any explanations and remarks you may think proper."

"I enclose your letter to me of the 24th February last, with the list you sent me, all of which you will have the kindness to return with your completed
