Standing Resolutions.

Order of Connexional Collections.

The collections in aid of the Connexional Funds shall be taken up in the following order, viz.:

- 1. Contingent Fund.—In the months of September and March.
- 2. Superannuated Ministers' Fund.—In the month of October or November.
- 3. Educational Fund.—In the month of February or April.
- 4. SABBATH SCHOOL FUND.—In the month of September.
- 5. GENERAL CONFERENCE FUND.—In the month of July.

Collections for Connexional Funds.

That it is the judgment of this Conference, that when collections for Connexional purposes are appointed to be taken in any of our churches, the whole of such collections throughout the day shall be appropriated to the respective Funds to which they are related, without any deduction for the Circuit, or any Trust or other Fund.
