
Connecting Rod on Ocean Limited Breaks Near Painsec Jct.



The boy was an exceptionally bright lad and very well liked in the community. With two companions, the Reid brothers, he had been hunting for wood and logs along the shore when the accident happened. The two other boys were on the shore at the time and young Fenelon was out on the catamaran of planks overhanging the water. It is believed that he either fell or rolled off. He was making his way shorewards when he was seen to go under and before help could reach him he was lost.


