829,000,000 BUSHELS OF WHEAT FORECAST

Considerable Falling Off for Winter Crop - Apple and Peach Crops Also Anticipated Lower.

Washington, June 13 - The country's combined winter and spring wheat crop promises to be 43,000,000 bushels larger than last year's total of 829,000,000 bushels - based on forecasts of production announced by the Department of Agriculture. There will be a large crop of oats, barley and hay and last year. The apple crop will not be half as large as that of 1920 and the peach crop will be much smaller.

Winter wheat, which a month ago promised a crop of 629,000,000 bushels, came through May in bad shape in Kansas, Nebraska and Oklahoma States, as a result the forecast of production showed a reduction of 51,000,000 bushels, bringing the total to the same quantity as produced last year.

The spring wheat crop forecast indicates 43,000,000 bushels more than last year's crop. The condition of the crop is better than a year ago, while the acreage is somewhat smaller. An acre yield of 13.9 bushels is forecast, compared with 10.8 bushels last year.

Production forecasts, the condition of the crops on June 1, and acreages planted, follow:

Winter Wheat - Production forecast, 578,000,000 bushels; total, 77.9.

Spring Wheat - Production, 251,000,000; total, 93.4; acreage, 18,023,000.

All Wheat - Production, 829,000,000; condition, 82.0; acreage, 26,746,000.

Oats - Production, 1,405,000; condition, 85.7; acreage, 44,829,000.

Barley - Production, 181,000,000; condition, 87.1; acreage, 17,138,000.

Rye - Production, 71,000,000; condition, 90.2.

Hay - Production, 101,000,000; condition, 85.0.

Apples - Production, 108,000,000; condition, 41.8.

Peaches - Production, 31,700,000; condition, 45.5.

WHERE IS BOTTOM?

(Toronto Globe.)

Predictions of a return of prosperity were more freely made, perhaps, some months ago than at the present time, because each month's delay tends to confound the prophets, but at the same time brings the actuality that much nearer. Much consideration has been given to the records of previous wars, and the time that elapsed before the business crisis following the war arrived and closed each cycle of the movement. The question now is, Will the ultimate point of rest to the decline in prices come soon or late? In the past, it has taken several years for the "water" of inflated prices to be all squeezed out, and if that rule still holds it may yet take considerable time before the desired prosperity shall return in visible form. Stock markets seem to be at a point of rest or equilibrium, with small swings due to temporary conditions affecting one group or another, and with the period of dividend passing apparently still uninflected. This passing of dividends has really affected Canada but slightly as yet, partly because the depression has

WANT OUR PULP

Washington, June 12 - A resolution by Senator Underwood, of Alabama, Democratic leader, creating a federal commission to confer with the Canadian government on revocation of orders restricting wood pulp exports to this country was reported favorably yesterday by the senate rules committee. Five representatives of the Dominion government and the provincial governments of Ontario and New Brunswick. If an agreement could not be reached the committee would recommend action by congress.

REASSURING SIGNS.

The reassuring signs comprise the reduction in railroad wages and the submission of labor generally to the cancelling of part of the premature wage advances of 1919 and 1920; unmistakable, though slow, improvement in railway traffic and earnings; the exceedingly strong position of the Federal Reserve and the consequent public recognition of the fact that the most presently menacing factor in the economy is the sharp recovery of several commodity markets in which demand was seen to be outrunning actual supplies; the settling of the uncertainties as to Germany's attitude on reparations, and not least of all, the testimony given to this country's economic position by the decision to deposit at New York the whole amount of Germany's cash payments.

They are, however, at the extreme northern boundary, three being washed by the Spuyten Duyvil creek. There are 790 farms in full operation in the Metropolitan district.
