Bank clerks throughout Ireland will strike on December 31 unless the directors of banks congent to recognize their union, an action which they have hitherto refused to take. This was decided upon at a conference of the Irigh Bank Clerks Union at Dublin light week. Fifty-six delegates at the meeting voted unanimously by favor of the strike, which will affect 3,000 out of a total of 3,700 bank clerks in Ireland.
